PLEASE CHECK YOUR SCHEDULES! IF YOU HAVE A JOB, YOU WILL NEED TO ASK IN ADVANCE FOR THE TIME OFF. THERE ARE SEVERAL REQUIRED EVENTS YOU MUST ATTEND. CHECK THE DATES TO MAKE SURE YOU CAN COMMIT BEFORE APPLYING!

The following rules and restrictions apply and will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED:**

1. All members of the court will remain unmarried during the one-year period of their reign.
2. All members of the court will be expected to exhibit good citizenship and good moral conduct during the school year as well as the summer break.
3. Misconduct in any form will not be condoned or tolerated and shall be grounds for immediate and summary removal.
4. Any form of misconduct (including, but not limited to pregnancy, use of alcohol, use of drugs, or any conflict with the law) brought to the attention of the selection committee will be discussed and acted upon by the committee as a whole. After meeting with the candidate and her parents, any recommendations made by the committee will be addressed with the President. All decisions by the committee shall be final and binding.
