This is a semi-formal event and the girls should dress for a picture in the local paper. There is no charge to participate or compete.

The Queen's Pageant will be held Thursday, May 7th at 7pm at the Payette High School Auditorium! We will go over all the details at the Tea.

Each finalist will be required to go on stage and participate in an opening dance routine and answer one random question the Civic League members have chosen. The contestants will be judged on Confidence, Stage Presence and Personality Presentation.

If chosen as the Junior Princess, she will be required to participate during the Apple Blossom Festival week and attend all required activities with the Senior Court.

A detailed timeline of events will be available at the Tea, this schedule is for the entire court and not everything is applicable to the Junior Princess.

It is up to the parents if they want her to be involved in the other activities throughout the year.

Applicants must live in Payette, Idaho and may attend the Payette School District or Treasure Valley Classical Academy.
